Student Aid Application

Rules, Regulations, and Eligibility Requirements

- 1. The applicant shall be a graduating high school senior, a verified GED recipient, or a verified (by registrar) full time college freshman the time he/she submits this application.
- 2. Application for student Aid will need to be completed in full and submitted to the Student Aide Committee no later than the 25 March, 2023.
- 4. A high school applicant must submit an official transcript of his/her high school credits, SAT/ACTscores. Transcript should be in sealed envelopes.
- 5. A college freshmen student must submit a transcript of his/her college credits, GPA. Transcript should be in sealed envelopes.
- 6. Two letters of recommendation must accompany the application (none from relatives). One of which must be from someone in the community and the other an academic reference.
- 7. Applicants must provide a biographical sketch including applicants future career plans (typed-one page maximum).
- 8. Applicants will provide a typed, double-spaced essay, not to exceed two pages, entitled, "Why attending college is important to me."
- 9. Copy of Acceptance letters.
- 10. A yearbook picture that will not be returned.
- 11. Only high school graduating seniors are eligible to compete in the next level scholarship a.
- 12. Applicants will be evaluated on need, academic performance, community activities, honors,
